

General Information


Located in the centre of Brussels, in the Marolles district, next to Les Brigittines.


The building consists of a ground floor, three upper floors and a lift.

On the first three floors there is an apartment and loft. The apartments can accommodate between 1 and 3 people. The lofts sleep between 2 and 3 people.


Each unit has a fully equipped kitchen, bathroom, storage cupboards, lounge with sofas, balcony, extra beds and Wi-Fi connection.

Bed linen and towels are provided, as well as a cot (on request).














Flat 1 et 2


















Flat 3 Mezzanine

Cancellation Policy

You can ring the intercom and a member of the team will welcome you.


HORAIRES
